

SLHS Chorus Financial Aid or Payment Plan Form

Our goal at South Lakes is to include students in all Chorus activities regardless of financial concerns. Families can apply for assistance from FCPS through free and reduced lunch program. By completing two forms your student may qualify for Equal Opportunity Funds that can cover the cost of FCPS course fees.

To apply for Free and Reduced lunch please complete the following 2 forms:

1. 2018-2019 Confidential Household Application for Free and Reduced Price Meals
2. 2018-2019 Fairfax County Public Schools Consent to Share Information for Benefits for Other Programs

Please make sure you download the 18-19 forms which will be updated in the next month.

You must complete both forms to be eligible for Equal Opportunity Funds.

These two forms for 2018-2019 **should be returned to the SLHS Principals Assistant or to the school Finance Officer.** This return date can be after August 15, 2018 but should be completed by September 21, 2018. Return the bottom portion of this form to Mrs. Gigliotti to notify him of your interest of financial support. Students should also see their school guidance counselor and ask about other financial aid options. Counselors will be aware of other funds that can assist students with co-curricular, or extra-curricular events.

Any student who requires aid should contact the Choral Director (Rita Gigliotti, ragigliotti@fcps.edu or Susan McCormick smccormick@fcps.edu) prior to payment deadlines. All financial aid matters are held in confidence. Only the Choral Director and the appropriate FCPS designee will know about students who qualify for Free/reduced meals, school financial aid applications, or payment plans.

The Parents for Choral Arts (Booster organization) will also offer Extra-Curricular scholarship funds for activities such as the Spring trip and Broadway Night. To qualify for extra-curricular scholarships students are required to actively participate in fundraising events and complete any related applications. These events generate the funds that are to be distributed by the Parents for Choral Arts for extra-curricular scholarships.
